2026 Annual Scholarship Program

The Knights of Columbus (K of C) – St. Mary's Council #6202 (Cape May), affiliated with Our Lady Star of the Sea Church (OLSOS), is proud to offer an annual scholarship program to support the academic endeavors of dedicated students partaking in Catholic education that reside in Cape May County. This merit-based scholarship aims to encourage and assist students entering or attending a <u>Catholic</u> high school who demonstrate academic excellence, leadership, citizenship and active extracurricular involvement.

Scholarship Criteria

- ◆Applicants must carry a minimum cumulative **3.5 GPA** or **B+** average from their current academic institution in order to qualify for the K of C scholarship.
- ◆Applicants from middle schools [graduating eighth grade students] and current secondary school students must demonstrate a minimum B+ average <u>inclusive of mid-year grades</u> to qualify for the Catholic high school scholarship program.
- ◆ Catholic residents of Cape May County and especially parishioners of OLSOS are welcomed and encouraged to apply for the K of C scholarship.

Scholarship Specifications

- Merit scholarships are one-time awards of \$1000. Eligibility is restricted to students entering or currently attending a Catholic high school.
- Qualifications will be based on high academic achievement, written essay, extracurricular and community activities as well as overall application presentation.
- ◆ Scholarship funds will be <u>dispersed directly</u> to an awardee's Catholic high school account to help defray tuition costs.
- ◆Roman Catholic men, 18 years of age and older, are always welcomed and encouraged to join us and become a member of the K of C − St. Mary's Council #6202 (Cape May).

Scholarship Application Schedule

- ◆ March 1st Annual application deadline (no exceptions)
- ◆May 1st Award notifications will be sent out to all K of C Scholarship recipients



Scholarship Document Requirements

- ◆ Completed application available at the OLSOS parish office and as a downloadable PDF on the K of C St. Mary's Council #6202 (Cape May) ministry page of the church's website (www.ladystarofthesea.org) or scan the QR Code below for additional information
- ◆Current official academic transcript(s) indicating cumulative GPA only sent in a sealed envelope or electronically directly from applicant's school (student copies unacceptable)

 Note Official transcripts for any concurrent enrollment or dual-credit college courses taken during high school are also required
- ♦ Written essay explaining the significance of a Catholic education and demonstrating participation in extracurricular activities (500 700 words)
- ◆Resume highlighting academic achievements, activities and community involvement
- ◆ Two academic recommendations

Incomplete scholarship applications or those applicants who do not qualify, will not be considered!
