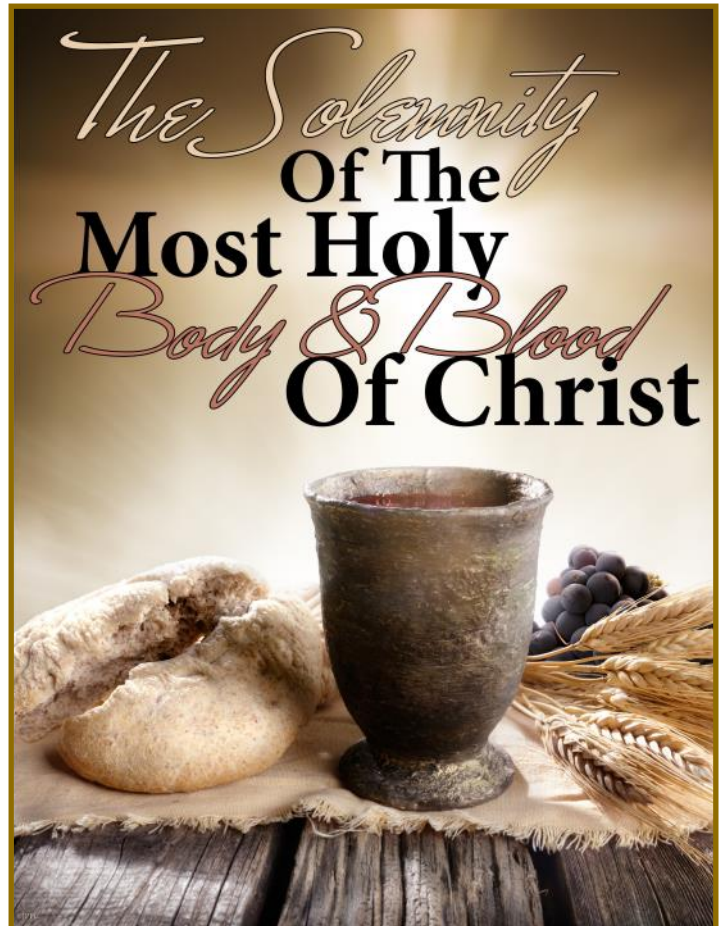

SALESIAN REFLECTION

Solemnity of Corpus Christi (6/11/2023)

Today we celebrate the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Here are some of St. Francis de Sales' thoughts on the Eucharist.

So that we might intimately be united with God's goodness, Jesus instituted the sacrament of the Eucharist. Our Savior desires us to be united to Him by a union so strong and close that we are marked with His features. In receiving the Eucharist our Lord carries us and does in us works altogether performed by Him. Whoever turns to the Eucharist frequently, and in a holy manner, builds up his or her spiritual health. If fruits that are tender and most subject to decay, such as strawberries, can easily be preserved a whole year in sugar and honey, it is no wonder that our hearts, no matter how frail and weak, are preserved by the spiritually real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

After you have received our Lord in the Eucharist, talk with Him about your inmost concerns. Reflect that He is within you and has come there for your happiness. Make Him as welcome as you possibly can. Conduct yourself in such a manner that by your actions all may know that God is with you.

Receive the Eucharist often. Two kinds of people ought to receive the Eucharist often: the strong and the weak. The strong, lest they become weak, and the weak that they may become strong. The sick that they may be cured, those in good health, that they may not fall sick. Persons who are involved in many worldly affairs need it. Those who labor much and are heavily burdened need to eat solid food and often.

In the Eucharist our Savior advances, strengthens and nourishes us with His self-giving love. Since Christ gives Himself totally to us in this Divine Sacrament, ought we not to give ourselves totally to Him, who is at once both Gift and Giver?

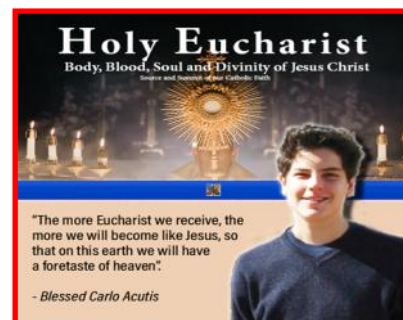

Dear Parishioners

I was required by the Diocese of Camden to submit my letter of resignation as pastor, as I will turn 75 on June 30th of this year. This is in keeping with church and diocesan policy for bishops and pastors when they reach the age of 75.

Thank you for the support and encouragement you have given me during my eight years at Our Lady Star of the Sea, and especially these last four years when I have served as your pastor.

They were years that had their challenges, especially with the mandated closing of the church for months during the pandemic. We weathered that storm and others through the hard work of the parish staff and the enduring commitment and generosity of you, our parishioners. The parish of Our Lady Star of the Sea as well as St. Agnes Church in Cape May Point remain strong.

I am most grateful for your dedication to prayer, and your ongoing commitment to the various and important ministries of the parish. Your example of faith, especially in times of illness and loss, has been a great inspiration to me. A pastor is truly blessed and encouraged by the faith of his parishioners.

Although I have been asked to retire as pastor, I plan to remain active in ministry. I will reside as the senior priest assisting at Our Mother of Consolation Parish in the Chestnut Hill section of Philadelphia. The parish is not far from the homes of my brothers and my nieces and nephews. I will have an opportunity to spend time with them and maybe even catch a Phillies or Eagles game now and then.

Please be assured that my community, the Oblates of St. Francis de Sales, remain committed to serving the parish of Our Lady Star of the Sea.

You will always be in my thoughts and prayers.

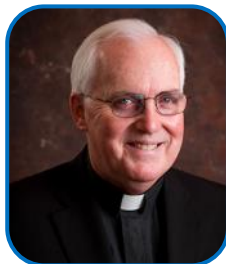
The **Eucharistic Procession** will begin immediately after the **11:00AM Mass** and walk down the **Washington Street Mall** and back to the Church.

While you may have chosen to be cremated, remember to choose your final resting place. Although the Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, it does not however, forbid cremation unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching. Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form. We should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead.

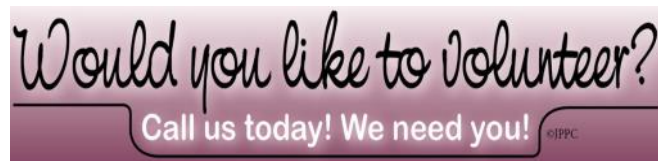

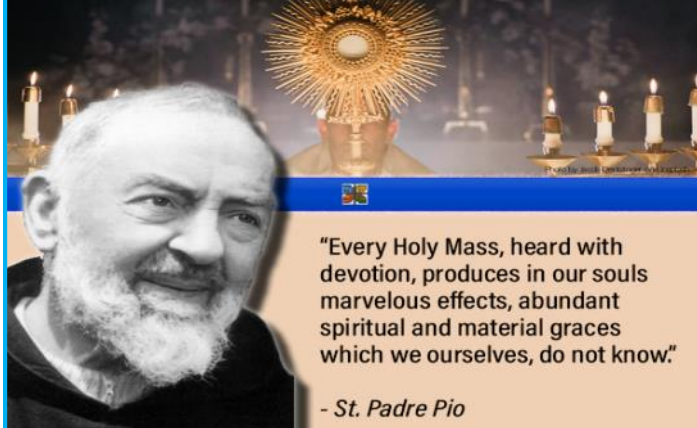
