

#### SALESIAN REFLECTION

#### 18<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time (8/3/2025)

Today's Scripture readings call us to do some reflecting on the way we live as a baptized follower of Jesus.

St. Paul reminds us that we have been given a share in the life of Jesus by our baptism. We are called to focus our way of living our daily life in a new way - a way that is influenced by Jesus' life, death and resurrection. As Jesus has told us: the only thing that gives our life here on earth ultimate value is remembering that life is a gift of God, and it is given to us to lead us to eternal life with God.

With that perspective in mind, we can appreciate the viewpoint of Qoheleth in today's first reading: "All things in this life are vanity" - a mere breath, a vapor - transient and ultimately empty. All the hard work and worry we may put into accumulating things here on earth - what will it ultimately matter when we come to die? The Lord isn't going to ask us: "How much did you make during your life?" He will ask us: "How much did you love?"

And our willingness to love flows from the new life given to us in baptism. Because we share the life of God, we are able to love as God loves. If we choose to live and love in this manner, then the way we live will be different from the way those live whose only concern is this world and all it has to offer.

In order to live and love as God does, we will have to learn to discipline our choices to follow the lead of grace. And grace will call us to rise above evil desires, passion, lust and uncleanness. Lying has no part in anyone who genuinely loves. Neither does prejudice nor discrimination. Love is about treating everyone with dignity and respect as brothers and sisters who are the image of the Creator.

All of us can benefit from some prayerful reflection ...continued in the next column

on today's word from our God. May our reflection lead us to grow in knowledge and grace. May we be formed anew each day in the image of our Creator. Then our daily living will help us to grow rich in the sight of God and bring us ultimately to share his life forever.

Feast of the Assumption ~ Friday, August 15

The Wedding of the Sea

An Our Lady Star of the Sea Church tradition will take place once again as we celebrate the "Wedding of the Sea" after the 11AM Mass on the Feast of the Assumption.

Following the Mass, a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be carried in a procession down Ocean Street from the church to the beach for the traditional "Wedding of the Sea" ceremony.

According to tradition, the ceremony commemorates an event in the life of the Bishop of Cervia in Italy, Paul Barbo, who later became Pope Paul II. The Bishop is said to have been returning by ship from Venice on the Feast of the Assumption in 1445 when he was caught in a storm. The Bishop, it is said, calmed the storm by prayer and throwing his pastoral ring into the sea.

The "Wedding of the Sea" is a popular centuries old rite in many European seacoast cities and towns like Venice. The ceremony symbolizes the Wedding of the Sea and the City created by God, in proximity to each other, and blessed by His love and protection.

After the blessing, a lifeguard will assist Bishop Sullivan by casting a floral garland into the surf.

Cremation and Proper Handling of Cremated Remains Your Choices Don't Stop with Cremation

While you may have chosen to be cremated, remember to choose your final resting place. Although the Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, it does not however, forbid cremation unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching. Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form. We should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead.
